1.1 SAFETY POLICY

NASL supports best aviation industry practices regarding safety and intends to provide all employees with a safe and healthy working environment.


Managers shall apply the company's risk management values and procedures to all of their activities.

All employees are required to report accidents, incidents or safety hazards in accordance with the company's reporting procedures. No disciplinary action shall be taken against any employee who acts to prevent an injury or who reports any accident, incident or hazard.

All employees are required to adopt the standards and procedures set forth in the Safety Management Program. Failure to comply with this safety policy by any employee at any level will result in disciplinary action.
